The Tormaukin is a traditional old inn turned exclusive-use country retreat, perfect for special getaways with your nearest and dearest.



Tucked away in the heartland of Perthshire amidst the beautiful scenery of Glendevon, escape to the Scotland of your wildest imaginings. ### A Central Location

Taking a look at the bigger picture, the Tormaukin enjoys a prime location minutes away from Gleneagles, and is less than an hour from Edinburgh and Glasgow, and twenty minutes from Stirling & Perth.

Travelling to us
The Tormaukin is on the A823, just off the A9. Edinburgh airport is less than an hour away, while the nearest train station is at Gleneagles, which offers a direct train to London King's Cross in 5.5 hours

The nearest bus station is in Auchterarder, 15 minute's drive away. There are a number of local taxi and minibus companies, which we recommend booking in advance.

### The Garden Room

Our brightest light-filled space, bursting with plants & shabby chic furnishings, the French doors open out onto the patio garden when the sun is shining.

With ideal lighting for photos, the space is the perfect spot for afternoon tea and can also be converted into a dance-floor. The adjoining outdoor patio is the perfect spot for a summer BBQ or garden party, to eat, drink or lounge on its garden furniture.

### The Dining Room

A grand and ambient space, with green, brass & walnut, the dining room is the heart of the house. featuring a long banquet table which can seat up to 30 persons (or 50 at separate tables)

### Olde Inn Bedrooms



Our seven olde inn bedrooms blend Scottish heritage with original period features, from grand and traditional to plush and contemporary. Each room is ensuite with walk-in showers, except for the golden 'Boudoir' which possesses a roll-top bath. Four of these rooms can comfortably fit an extra z-bed.



### Coach-House Bedrooms



Our three Coach-House rooms are quaint and cosy, decked in traditional tartans and named after local points of interest. Perfect for guests enjoying outdoor pursuits, they are external to the main inn and have their own entrances, ideal for those who seek to come and go as they please.

An extra z-bed can fit into two of these rooms, to make them twinnable, or to sleep an extra occupant for £25 extra per night.

These rooms are suitable for those with mobility issues as they are on the ground-floor. Please note, there is a small step at their entry for wheelchairs. Each bedroom has a brand-new refurbished ensuite bathroom, and has a bath with overhead shower. Dogs are more than welcome in these rooms for an extra £25 cleaning fee each.


# Have Your Own Pub!




